Before the Interview

1. Do Your Research

- Think of 2–3 examples that show how you've solved problems, worked as part of a team, or demonstrated leadership.
- Use the **STAR method** (Situation, Task, Action, Result) to keep your answers clear and impactful.

3. Review the Job Description

- Match your skills and experiences with the requirements listed.
- Be ready to explain how you can add value in that role.

During the Interview

1. Be Yourself

- We want to get to know the real you—your strengths, values, and motivations.

2. Communicate Clearly

- Listen carefully to each question.
- Take a moment to think before responding—clear, thoughtful answers stand out more than quick ones.

3. Show Your Interest

- Share why Riverside (or the company you're applying to) is a good fit for you.
- Ask questions that show genuine curiosity about the role, team, or culture.

4. Highlight Teamwork & Compassion

- At Riverside, collaboration and patient-centered care are at the heart of what we do.
- Whenever possible, share examples that show your teamwork, adaptability, and empathy.

After the Interview

1. Send a Thank-You

- A short email or note thanking your interviewers for their time goes a long way.
- Mention something specific you discussed to make it personal.

2. Reflect on the Experience

- Jot down what went well and what you'd improve next time.
- This helps you learn and feel more prepared for future interviews.

3. Stay Positive & Patient

- *Hiring decisions take time.* While you wait, continue your job search and keep building skills.

Extra Tips for Success Anywhere

- **Dress professionally** (whether in person or virtually).

- **Be punctual**—arrive 10–15 minutes early, or log into a virtual interview a few minutes ahead.
- **Test your tech** if it's an online interview.
